Testing

The Secaucus Police Department is Non-Civil Service and utilizes an entry level examination in its hiring process. The examination components for Police Officer are as follows:

- ✓ Written Examination (65% or higher)
- ✓ Physical Fitness Test (Pass/Fail)
- ✓ Oral Examination (70% or higher)



Requirements for Applicants

Pursuant to the Town Ordinances, requirements for applicants include but are not limited to the following:

- Excellent verbal and written communications skills
- Strong presentation skills
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Minimum twenty-one (21) years of age
- In good health and physical condition (physical examination required)
- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent

- A minimum sixty (60) credits from an accredited college or two (2) years full time active service in the U.S. Military; service in the Reserve Component or National Guard equates to 2.5 college credits for each month of full time service or .25 college credits for each full day “drill or annual training”
- Must possess a valid NJ driver’s license
- Must pass a background investigation, drug tests and medical and psychological examinations.

Salary and Benefits

- The Secaucus Police Department offers a competitive entry level salary and generous benefits including, Medical, Dental & Prescription Drug Plans and Educational Benefits.
- We believe that a well-trained police professional will have a favorable impact on the diverse communities they serve and will be respected by their peers, we offer training utilizing technology, research and development, and instruction to ensure that members of the Secaucus Police Department continue to develop.
